CERTIFIED: Login to you online account to check if your parcels require certification.

NMP Certification for Growers; attend a training/pass test and maintain 3 hours of Continuing Education Units (CEUs) every 3 years. Member required to track CEUs.

Training: Certification and CEU trainings are available in January-February

SECP Certification for Growers; attend a training/pass test. Keep SECP current.

Training: On-line SECP trainings will be available in January – February

NOTE: Members are required to complete an education ‘event’ per calendar year on water quality, including online trainings and newsletters.
