### CERTIFIED:

**NMP Certification for Growers;** attend a training/pass test and maintain 3 hours of Continuing Education Units (CEUs) every 3 years. Member required to track CEUs.

**SECP Certification for Growers;** attend a training/pass test. Keep SECP current. Members are required to complete an education 'event' per calendar year on water quality, including online trainings and newsletters.
